Maryland Outstanding Technology Leader in Education Award

PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

Announcing MICCA's annual Maryland Outstanding Technology Leader in Education Award. This award recognizes an educator outside the classroom who has made exemplary contributions to the implementation of technology in Maryland schools.

Eligibility

Any full-time educator or administrator employed by an educational entity in the state of Maryland, whose primary job responsibility is not teaching in an Early Childhood through Grade 12 classroom.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

Only one nomination will be accepted from each Maryland school system, AIMS (the Association of Independent Maryland Schools), the Baltimore archdiocese, the Washington archdiocese, the Maryland State Department of Education and each higher education institution. Please be sure to determine the process for nominating and selecting a winner within your system, group or institution. The MICCA Technology Award Committee will select a state winner from the nominations received according to the scoring criteria provided online at www.miccaonline.org. The nomination must be submitted with the following:

1. Official Nomination Cover Form for Maryland Outstanding Technology Leader Using Technology Award

2. Nomination Statement that describes the nominee's work in the following categories:

A. Establishment, implementation and modeling of a shared vision for the comprehensive integration of technology to maximize student learning (MTSSA I, II, VI)

B. Enhancement of professional practice and productivity through the use of technology (MTSSA III, IV, V)

C. Demonstration of significant impact and involvement on technology use in education at the local, state, national, and/or global level (MTSSA – V, II)

D. Facilitation of collaborative efforts to advance the use of technology (MTSSA- II, IV)

3. Supporting Artifacts-You may submit up to **two** artifacts to support category A. You may submit **one additional** artifact from either category B, C, or D. No more than 3 artifacts will be accepted.

AWARD PRESENTATION

The state award winner will be announced at the 2009 MICCA Spring Conference. The award includes:

- Technology gift from Dell Computer
- One-year membership in MICCA
- An award plaque
- Conference registration fee
- Lodging for one night at the conference hotel
- Submission as MICCA's nomination for the ISTE Outstanding Technology Leader in Education Award. **A resume and three letters of recommendation will be required for submission to ISTE.**
